PURPOSE OF MOU

In particular, this MOU is intended to

1. Improve the Personality Development of the students of the First Party.
2. Teach the Positive mental attitude.
3. Communication skills, Goal setting.
4. Presentation Skills and Time Management.
5. Body Language, Tonal variations, Etiquettes.

NOW THERE FORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Clause1

CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 The co-operation between First Party and Second Party will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the Second Party, providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/ training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the First Party.

Clause 2

SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community, to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 The Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching/training methodology so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.3 The Second Party will train the students of the First Party on Personality Development and skills in order to bridge the gap in skills and make them ready for good communication and for Placement.
- 2.4 The Personality Development course will be for 24hours (1Hours per session x 24 sessions)
- 2.5 This course will be done one day per week ie, Friday.
- 2.6 The course will be done in 2 batches (50students/batch). Two batches will run simultaneously
- 2.7 Timings recommended-3:00 pm -4.30 pm

3.1 The validity of the agreement is one year from the date of the agreement.

3.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

3.3 Any dispute will be settled in an amicable way between the two parties.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (“**MoU**”) is entered into and made effective on this 1st day of February 2025 (“**Effective Date**”) at Delhi, by and between:

HORIBA India Pvt. Ltd., a company registered under the Registrar of Companies and having its registered office at 246, Okhla Industrial Estate, Phase-III, New Delhi 110020 through its training institute - **HORIBA India Technical Institute** at Plot No B-3 & C-32, MIDC Butiberi Phase II, Industrial Area, Nagpur, Maharashtra 441122 (hereinafter HORIBA India Pvt. Ltd. is referred to as “**HORIBA**” and HORIBA India Technical Institute is referred to as “**HITI**”) of the first Part.

AND

Madras Medical Mission College of Health Sciences, a unit of **Madras Medical Mission** and having its registered office at 36/1, Tulip Avenue, Indira Gandhi Street, Golden George Nagar, Mogappair, Golden George Nagar, Chennai 600107, represented by its Principal, Dr. Deepa CPhilip, (referred hereinafter as “**College/MMMCHS**”) of the other Part

HORIBA is a subsidiary of HORIBA LTD Japan and is engaged in the business of providing an extensive array of instruments and systems for applications ranging from automotive R&D, process and environmental monitoring, in-vitro medical diagnostics, semiconductor manufacturing and metrology, to a broad range of scientific R&D and QC measurements. HITI is engaged in the activity of providing industry-focused trainings and research facilities to students and working professionals of certain medical and paramedical domains and has the mandate and power to establish linkages with national and international bodies and institutions for the purpose of enhancing and expanding the quality of education and research.

The Madras Medical Mission College of Health Sciences a Unit of Madras Medical Mission a charitable organization is affiliated with Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai conducts seven undergraduate and two post graduate programmes.

MMMCHS wishes to collaborate with HORIBA for the purpose of conducting skill training programs and workshops for paramedical students at “**MMMCHS Premises**” on the terms and conditions as stipulated under this MoU.

For the purpose of this MoU, HORIBA and MMMCHS shall be collectively referred to as “**Parties**” and individually as a “**Party**”.

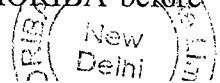
NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, undertakings and conditions set forth herein below, and for other valid consideration, the acceptability and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby agree and are to be legally bound as follows:

TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING:

1. The broad objective of this MoU is to develop a partnership between the Parties for conducting skill training programs and workshops for paramedical students at the MMMCHS Premises
2. This MoU shall remain valid for a period of 2 (two) years commencing from the Effective Date, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the terms of this MoU. This MoU shall be renewable upon mutual consent of the Parties.
3. HITI shall conduct 3 (three) to 4 (four) workshops per year on various relevant topics for Bachelor of Science (BSC) and Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) students at MMMCHS Premises, on dates that are mutually agreed by the Parties.
4. The skill training programs and workshops shall cover topics like Hematology, Biochemistry, Coagulation and Quality Control
5. MMMCHS shall provide a room suitable to accommodate the students with audio-visual facility and a suitable place to demonstrate the requisite instruments.
6. MMMCHS shall be responsible for providing the paramedical students with transportation facilities to and from the HORIBA Nagpur facility for a 2 (two) day workshop and an industrial visit, on mutually agreed dates by the Parties
7. A joint branding certificate shall be issued to the students for each workshop. Such certificate shall be issued by HITI, and the cost of issuance of such certificate shall be borne by HORIBA.
8. HORIBA shall manage the speakers and instruments required for the abovementioned workshop and programs.
9. The College may advertise the workshop information through their website and social media platforms. HORIBA permits the College to publicize its association with HITI through their website, brochures and advertisements. However, the College acknowledges that such permission shall be limited solely to publicizing the arrangement outlined herein. Any promotional materials containing HORIBA/HITI's tradename or trademarks must receive prior written approval from HORIBA before being published by the College.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS:

1. In consideration of conducting the workshops as per the terms of this MoU, HITI shall charge an amount of INR 500 /- (Rupees five hundred only) from MMMCHS per student, per day for attending the workshop ("Fee"). It is clarified that this fee applies on a per student per day basis.
2. HIN shall raise an invoice for each workshop conducted, shortly after conclusion of the relevant workshop
3. Payment for the Fee shall be made by the College to HORIBA within 30 (thirty) days from conducting the workshop in the following bank account:

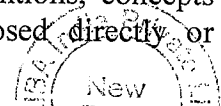
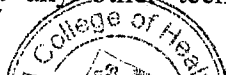

MONITORING COMMITTEE:

1. For the smooth, effective, and transparent implementation of the workshops, the Parties shall form a monitoring committee comprising of the following persons ("**Committee**"):
 - i. A representative from HORIBA's finance department
 - ii. Principal /head of HITI
 - iii. Principal of MMMCHS; and
 - iv. Director Administration, MMMCHS
2. The Committee, consisting of the aforementioned personnel shall hold a meeting either physically or digitally at least once every 6 (six) months and finalize various plans and reports pertaining to implementation of the programs/workshops. It shall also review the financials and discuss any other matter that the Committee may deem appropriate. The decisions will be taken mutually between the two Parties. However, The decision of HORIBA's representative will be the deciding factor in the above matters between the two Parties.

CONFIDENTIALITY:

1. '**Confidential Information**' means any information, which shall include but is not limited to, design, fabrication and assembly drawings, know-how, processes, product specifications, raw materials, trade secrets, market opportunities, or business or financial affairs or customers, product samples, inventions, concepts and any other technical and/or commercial information, disclosed directly or



indirectly and in any form whatsoever including, but not limited to, disclosure made in writing, oral or in the form of samples, models, computer programs, drawings or other instruments of/furnished by **HORIBA to MMMCHS** under this MoU.

2. MMMCHS agrees that it shall protect the Confidential Information with the same degree of care as it normally uses to preserve and safeguard its own proprietary information of like nature, but not less than a reasonable degree of care, use Confidential Information solely for the purposes of this MoU; and disclose Confidential Information only on a need-to-know basis to effect the purposes of this MoU and only to its employees, advisors, agents and affiliates who have undertaken an obligation of confidentiality substantially similar to that contained herein.
3. All proprietary Information shall be safeguarded by MMMCHS as required by this MoU for a period of 2 (two) years from the date of disclosure to MMMCHS. All trade secret information shall be safeguarded by MMMCHS as required by this MoU in perpetuity or for so long as such information remains a trade secret under applicable law, whichever occurs first.

SEVERABILITY:

If any provision of this MoU or part thereof is held to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable under any present or future law, such provision or part shall be fully severable and this MoU shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal, invalid or unenforceable provision or part were never a part hereof.

ASSIGNMENT:

The Parties shall not assign or transfer any of its obligations to any third-party under this MoU without the prior written consent of the other Party.

WAIVER (IF ANY):

A waiver by a Party hereto of any of its rights or remedies under this MoU on any occasion shall not be a bar to the exercise of the same right or remedy on any subsequent occasion or of any other right or remedy at any time.

TERMINATION OF MOU:

1. This MoU may be terminated by either Party by providing the other Party with a prior written notice of not less than 60 (sixty) days of its intention to do so, however, the Parties shall do so without dishonoring any commitment entered into prior to the date of issuance of such notice of termination.

2. This MoU may be terminated by either Party upon providing a prior written notice of 7 (seven) days to the other Party on occurrence of any of the following events:
3. the other Party is in material breach of this MoU;
4. a petition in bankruptcy is filed by or against the other Party or the other Party shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors or take advantage of any insolvency or other laws affording protection against creditors;
5. outcome of legal proceedings wherein the other Party is a party;
6. act of State;
7. Act of GOD; or
8. any exigencies beyond the normal control of the Party concerned and which would disable any of the parties hereto from functioning further.

AMENDMENTS TO THE MOU

1. No amendments to this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing after mutual discussions and agreement of the Parties or their authorized representative and specially stating the same to be amendments to this MoU.




INDEMNITY



GOVERNING LAW, DISPUTE RESOLUTION AND JURISDICTION

1. Whenever any dispute or difference arises between the Parties hereto, related to or connected with or arising out of *inter-alia*, the interpretation, construction or validity of this MoU, or its implementation, both the Parties shall in first instance try to resolve such dispute through mutual amicable consultation and mutual negotiations.
2. In the event the Parties are unable to resolve the dispute or differences through consultation and mutual negotiations within 15 (fifteen) days of issuance of a notice by a Party, the same shall be referred to arbitration by a sole arbitrator to be appointed jointly by both the Parties as per the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended from time to time or statutory notifications or amendments or re-enactment thereto for the time being in force. The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English language and the seat and venue of arbitration shall be New Delhi, India. The award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the







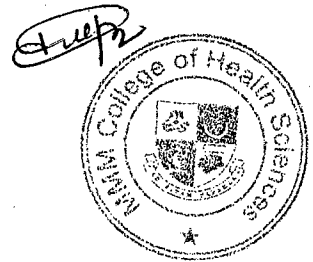


proprietary and technical information, that is generated and made available in any and all the premises of Sundaram Medical Foundation (SMF) that is generated or made available in the course of their assignment.


Data privacy information: All Personally identifiable data of individuals will be kept confidential and used only for the official or medical purposes for which the consent from relevant parties are obtained.

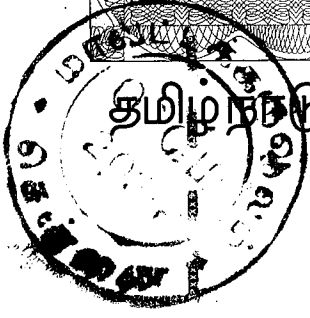

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Preamble:


