Hematology is a branch of medicine concerned with the study of blood, blood forming organs such as bone marrow, and blood related disorders and diseases. It deals with laboratory diagnosis, prevention care, treatment of diseases related to blood.

Latest advancements in Hematology

- Vein Finder technology:

Infrared Vein Viewer, Laser Vein Finder, or Vein Illuminator, that projects a real-time image of a patient's veins onto their skin's surface. It helps healthcare professionals locate veins accurately, facilitating procedures such as venipuncture, IV insertion, and blood draws.

- Artificial Intelligence (AI) application for leukemia diagnosis:

Computer Aided Diagnosis (CAD) systems based on image processing and Deep Learning (DL) and Convolutional Neural Networks (CNN) by automatically detecting lymphoblasts, can help the pathologist in performing a preliminary screening of the blood samples.

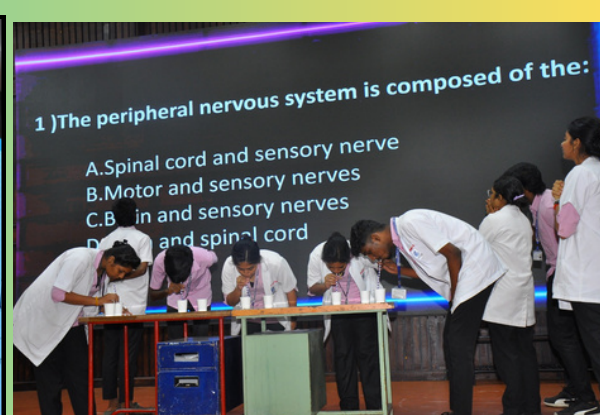

PG students of MSc CN & MSc MLT attended Research day seminar at The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University on 26th Sept 2024.

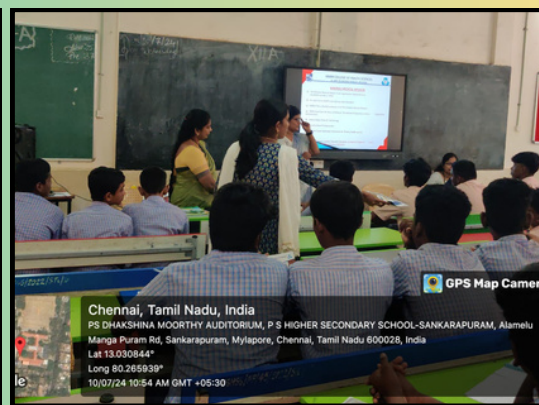


Promotion Activity

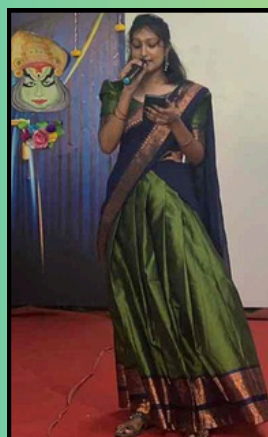
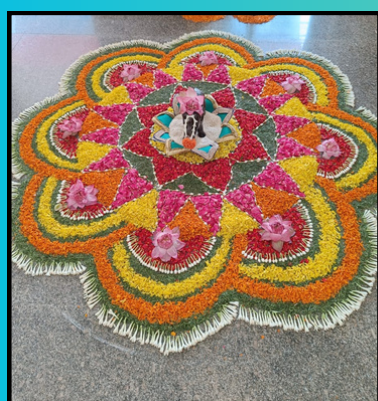
